## **NOTIFICATION**


Subject: **Re-opening of University**

In accordance with the Government of Pakistan's decision regarding re-opening of Universities/Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) with effect from September 15, 2020 and necessary preparations/actions for re-opening taken by the University, Sir Syed University of Engineering & Technology, Karachi has promulgated the following measures/steps.

It has been decided that Online Education Policy will continue to be implemented. However, in case of need for face- to- face on campus activity or compulsory conduction of laboratory/studio classes etc., limited students will be allowed to enter the University with effect from September 19, 2020.

The following guidelines (SOPs) have been issued in order to protect the health of students, faculty, and staff intending to return to campus.

1. To wear a mask at all times anywhere in campus.
2. Use of only the designated entrances and exits.
3. Read all instructions carefully contained in the awareness boards and banners placed at the Walk through Gate and other significant points.
4. To pass/enter the University through sanitized walk through gates.
5. Mandatory temperature checks through infra-thermo guns at the entrance.
6. To maintain social/ physical distancing of 6 feet in classrooms, laboratories, libraries, cafeterias, offices, corridors, staircases, and lifts.
7. Use communal facilities, e.g., kitchens, canteens, meeting rooms, printers and photocopiers only in accordance with the designated protocols, as it may be necessary to stagger usage or to continue to hold remote meetings so as to maintain social distancing.
8. To maintain good hygiene practices. Washing of hands thoroughly with soap and water or use a hand sanitizer, drying the hands before leaving the bathroom. Use a tissue (and dispose it off properly) or the crook of your elbow when coughing or sneezing.
9. Anyone experiencing COVID -1 9 symptoms, or a member of whose household has developed these symptoms, or if they have been in a contact with a COVID- 19 infected person not to return to campus.
10. Review latest updates and general guidance regarding COVID-19 related information on University, HEC or any other designated website.
11. Limit movement around the campus.
