

Frequently Asked Questions

1. When will the admissions begin?

Please refer to our website www.ssuets.edu.pk for updated information.

2. Are campus tours / visits open?

Campus tours / visits are open for applicants and their parents during visiting hours i.e. Monday to Friday 9:00 am to 05:00 pm subject to adhering to strict SOPs like mandatory wearing of masks, sanitizers, transparent water bottles etc.

3. Where are you located?

ST-16 University Rd, Block 5 Gulshan-e-Iqbal, Karachi, Karachi City, Sindh.

4. Will I be eligible to apply if I am waiting for results or appearing in final year exams?

Yes, all those candidates whose Intermediate / A level / Equivalent exams / results are delayed due to the COVID-19 threat are eligible to apply for admissions in Fall 2021 semester at SSUET.

5. What is the process to apply for admissions?

The process to apply for admissions is as follows:

Step 1: Go to the SSUET's online application portal

Step 2: Register yourself to login to the portal

Step 3: Fill out all the sections of the form respectively. Make sure that you have filled all the fields where information is required.

Step 4: Upload the documents in required format.

Step 5: Save and submit the application.

Step 6: Pay the application fee through online mode or manual mode. Once registered, the admit card will be issued before the admission test is scheduled.

Note: In case of having trouble while filling the form, email the screenshot of the issue with your Application ID at admissions@ssuets.edu.pk

6. How many undergraduate programs I can apply for?

Undergraduate applicants can apply for up to minimum 5 or maximum 10 programs.

7. Is it possible to make changes to the online application after submitting it?

No, you cannot make changes to the application once it is submitted. However, you can send a request to Admissions Office on admissions@ssuets.edu.pk for desired changes in your application details.

8. What if I am having trouble submitting my form?

To be able to submit your application, every section must be ticked as complete. Please avoid clicking multiple times as this can also cause problems. If it locks your attempts, this will reset automatically after two minutes.

9. What is the last date for submission of forms and for the aptitude test?

10. What will be the Admission test consist of?

Candidate has to attempt an aptitude test that will comprise over the MCQs questions to the standard of HSC (Intermediate Science/commerce) as per applied program.

- The Admission Test will consist of minimum five components according to the Chosen program. For Undergraduate Programs Test components will be English, Logical & Reasoning / General Knowledge, Maths/ Business Maths, Physics, (Computer/ Biology / Chemistry / Statistics).
- Applicants interested in Architecture programs will be assessed through Drawing test and interview conducted by the university in addition to the aptitude test.
- University conducts its own GAT based MS, PhD entry test. However, we also consider GAT-NTS for admission in Postgraduate Programs.

11. What is the duration of the aptitude test?

Duration of the Test shall be two to three hours according to the chosen program.

12. When will the result of the aptitude test be announced?

Admission aptitude test result is announced on SSUET website www.ssuets.edu.pk . All candidates who pass the test as per the set threshold qualify for Department-wise Merit calculations.

13. What is the eligibility criteria for Engineering and Non-Engineering programs?

The minimum eligibility criteria to apply for Engineering Programs is 60% in a relevant discipline of Science as guided by the PEC, while 50% is the minimum percentage required to apply for Non-Engineering Programs with a relevant group of subjects as per the requirement of the chosen degree program.

The minimum required percentage to apply in BBA Program is 45%.

14. What is the criteria for foreign students?

HEC Foreign Student policy applies to subject students. They are required to attain HEC Equivalence Certificate and other regulatory bodies endorsement as well as

endorsement from Foreign Ministry of Pakistan to pursue higher studies in Pakistan. The Fee Structure for Foreign Students is different.

15. What is the criteria for A-level students?

A level students are required to provide passing evidence in minimum 3 Principal Subjects with required % of the applied program. Candidates must submit the IBCC Equivalence Certificate of O and A-Level Studies.

16. What is the criteria for Diploma Students in Engineering programs?

Candidates holding a 3-year Diploma /DAE (equivalent to Intermediate) in a relevant discipline are eligible for admission in engineering programs against DAE based quota if their scores are equivalent or above 60%. Candidates must submit their IBCC Equivalence Certificate of DAE.

17. How do you determine the merit?

The Admissions Committee will process the applications on the basis of merit as determined by the applicant's previous academic record and his /her performance in the aptitude test. Additional Marks for Hifz-e-Quran is applicable.

18. Is there any quota?

The admissions at SSUET are purely on open merit basis in all degree programs. However, there are DAE quota based seats available in Engineering programs as per the PEC Guidelines.

19. Is there any quota reserved for sports and sponsors?

The candidates who are outstanding sportsmen or recommended by any sponsor are eligible for admission under the reserved seats category provided candidates fulfil the eligibility criteria of the applied program.

20. What is the credit transfer policy from other universities?

The University will entertain students who wants to transfer at SSUET from any other HEC recognized universities in all discipline subject to availability of seats, moreover, fulfilling all the University's laid down rules for migration.

21. What does "provisionally accepted" mean?

Provisional admissions will be offered to all candidates who qualify as per Merit. Candidates will however be required to provide HSC / Equivalent mark sheet with having minimum marks as per eligibility criteria of the offered program soon after the announcement of their respective results. In case of non-submission or having secured lesser than the eligibility marks, the admission will be cancelled.
